The Marigold Southey Centre: Sports and Aquatic Centre

Rules (Version August 2011)

1. The Sports and Aquatic Centre is unfenced and unpatrolled for the purposes of *structured programs* only. There are no opportunities for 'free play'.
2. Learn To Swim participants are to be accompanied by a designated adult.
3. No glass or food may be brought into the Centre (including change rooms, Exercise Room and General Purpose Classroom). Plastic water bottles are accepted.
4. All signage and staff instructions are to be obeyed at all times.
5. Due to the nature of the Centre's rubber concourse, no high heel shoes may be worn – these can damage the floor.
6. Walking only within the Centre, please do not run.
7. Swimming caps must be worn at all times while in the pools.
8. No students are permitted within the Centre unless directly supervised by a staff member or parent/guardian.
9. No students are permitted into the Centre any earlier than 10 minutes prior to the beginning of their class, and all students must vacate the Centre no later than 15 minutes after the conclusion of their class.
10. Students may only enter the water once instructed by their teacher, and must vacate the water immediately upon conclusion of their class.
11. Strictly no diving into the pool unless instructed by staff.
12. No rough or dangerous play.
13. Three loud whistle blasts signal a Major Emergency. All pool users must vacate the pool immediately and follow the instruction of staff.
14. The use of electronic recording (including on mobile phones) is prohibited in the Centre unless authorised by the Aquatic Centre Manager.
15. Parents may not enter the change room of the opposite gender.
16. Student use of the Exercise Room and General Purpose Classroom is under teacher instruction only.

Enquiries within the Sports and Aquatic Centre

Please note that no enquiries may be directed to the PE Office – this is a work space for faculty teaching staff and not general aquatic staff. Thank you in advance for your consideration.

Emergency Procedures

In the event of a Major Emergency, three loud whistle blows will signify that both pools need to be vacated immediately. It is imperative that pools are cleared in a quick and orderly fashion. St Catherine's Sports and Aquatic Centre staff will need to tend to the emergency and therefore will be unable to supervise the pools. Emergency services may need to be called. It is paramount that the entries to the pool, including rear driveway, along with the pool concourse are kept totally clear.

In the event of a Major Emergency, lessons may need to be cancelled entirely for the remainder of the session, and in this unfortunate event, lesson costs will not be reimbursed to parents.

St Catherine's Sports and Aquatic Centre has put into place Pool Rules, staff supervision policies, signage, safety equipment and first aid equipment in an effort to reduce the likelihood of Major Emergencies. In the event of any other unforeseen circumstances (for example: power outage, plant breakdown, chemical imbalance, water biohazard) that cause the complete or partial closure of the swimming pool(s), lesson costs will not be reimbursed to parents. In the case of a total Centre evacuation, the main assembly point will be outside and down onto the Junior School Sports Field at the street front.

Payment and Re-enrolment

All program fees must be pre-paid prior to the beginning of each term. Failure to pay tuition fees will result in this participant's position in the program being immediately removed. Credit card and cheque payments are accepted. Re-enrolment into a new term must be completed and paid in full prior to the current term breaking for holidays. This is the responsibility of each family. Holiday Programs must be paid in full upon enrolling. Please note that St Catherine's School does not apply pro-rata charges to participants who join Aquatic Programs after a Term has already commenced. The original fee will apply.

Medical Conditions and periods of sickness

A condition of entry into any programs within the St Catherine's Sports and Aquatic Centre is that prior notification in writing is required for any serious medical conditions that may impact on the safety of an individual or others participating in programs within the Centre. It is a general consideration to other fellow members and staff that if a participant becomes ill around the day of their lesson that they do not attend. During any bouts of diarrhoea or gastro-related illness, swimmers must not attend swimming lessons until given clearance by a doctor.

Photography and Video Recording Policy and Permission

From time to time St Catherine's Sports and Aquatic Centre staff may take photos or video of the programs within the Centre. Material may be used as displays within the Centre, to support marketing material, to support articles in the media, to be displayed on our website or for staff training purposes. By initialling this section you give consent to photographs and video of you and your child being used in accordance with the uses outlined above.

Uniform / Dress Code

It is compulsory that all participants of Aquatic Programs within the Sports and Aquatic Centre wear swimming caps at all times whilst within the water. Girls are required to wear one piece bathers (bikini style bathers are not permitted) Likewise no board shorts may be worn by male participants. All males are to wear 'Speedo'-type bathers only.

Due to the nature of the pool's rubber concourse, no high heel shoes are permitted within the Centre as these can damage the floor.

Lost Property

Lost property that is left behind in the Sports and Aquatic Centre will be collected and stored within the Centre for a maximum of **one week**; after this time all lost property in good condition that is unclaimed will be forwarded to Student Services in the Senior School or to the Junior School office for processing. Unnamed items will be discarded. Please be sure to name all personal items.

IMPORTANT HYGIENE!

Please note that no soiled or dirty shoes are to be worn into the Sports and Aquatic Centre. Keeping a clean and hygienic concourse is imperative to ensuring that our pool water is kept healthy and hygienic.

Learn To Swim classes / Squad training sessions – afterschool policy and arrival times

Participants in the out of school hours Aquatic Program are not permitted in the Centre any earlier than 10 minutes prior to the beginning of their lesson. All aquatic lessons have specific start and finish times. It is important that participants arrive five minutes prior to the start time of each session (or earlier for squad sessions if specified by the coach) to ensure participant's do not interrupt classes once they have already begun. At the completion of all swimming lessons and squad sessions there is strictly no opportunity for free water play. All participants are to vacate the pool and head directly to the change-room. Once changed, participants are to vacate the Centre.

Grievances

Cancellations and Refunds

In the event of a student cancelling classes during a term or during holiday swimming there will be no refund or credit. In the event of a serious medical condition occurring, a submission in writing may be made, accompanied by a medical certificate that explicitly states that the cancellation of further classes is due to a current and serious medical condition that would exclude the student from participating in aquatic activities.

Missed Lessons and Make-up Sessions

Missed classes will be strictly at each participant's own expense. St Catherine's Sports and Aquatic Centre is not responsible for participants missing their designated aquatic sessions. Whilst opportunities for make-up classes may exist from time to time, they are in no way guaranteed. Make-up lesson availability can be sought from the Swim School Coordinator. Make-up classes may only be sought due to genuine medical reasons or times of genuine family hardship. A maximum of two make-up lessons may be sought per term. Participants may only participate in a make-up class if there is a position available at the appropriate level standard. Make-up lessons are strictly not carried over into subsequent new terms.

Assessments

St Catherine's Sports and Aquatic Centre operates on a continual assessment system. The teacher responsible for each swimmer will determine when they feel that a swimmer has satisfied the syllabus for each level, at which time the Swim School Coordinator will independently assess the swimmer and make a final judgement on whether the swimmer is ready to progress to the next level.

End of Evening Policy and After Hours Care Penalty

All participants participating in programs in the St Catherine's Sports and Aquatic Centre are strictly required to exit the Centre no later than 15 minutes after the conclusion of the last class for the evening.

IMPORTANT: Any Junior School student who has yet to be picked up after 15 minutes of the last class finishing will automatically be considered to be in After Hours Care and families invoiced at a rate of \$25/15 minutes. Efforts will be made to contact parents and guardians who do not show for pick-up. All families must provide details of an emergency family contact.

IMPORTANT : Any student who is entered into After Hours Care due to parents running late for pick up on two occasions within a single term will be removed from the program.

Conduct, Respect and Pool Rules

Staff of the St Catherine's Sports and Aquatic Centre are passionate about swimming and seeing participants achieve their potential in an environment that encourages learning and positive experience for which teams strive. Staff reserve the right to cancel a participant's aquatic sessions, with no refunds or credits given, in the event that a participant displays behaviour that is deemed inappropriate or disrespectful to fellow participant's, other parents or staff. Violent conduct or use of indecent language will be grounds for cancellation with no credits or refunds given. The Centre Rules are in place for participant, staff and spectator safety and wellbeing. The Centre Rules must be obeyed at all times; failure to do so may result in the cancellation or suspension of a participant's aquatic sessions. In the case that a membership is suspended for misconduct, a participant's position in the program will not be guaranteed once the suspension period has finished. **NOTE:** By initialling this section of the Policies and Procedures, you hereby declare that you have understood the St Catherine's Sports and Aquatic Centre Rules (version August 2011) and are aware of the importance of obeying the Centre's rules.
