

## St Catherine's School Expectation of English Proficiency and Educational Qualifications

All Full Fee Paying Overseas Students are required to complete and submit their results from an AEAS English Proficiency Test. In assessing whether an offer will be made to a prospective student, the following are considered:

- 1. A student must have achieved a minimum of 50 out of 100 for their English Assessment Score.
- 2. The student's stanine ranking for Non- Verbal Reasoning ability and Mathematics Reasoning ability is also taken into consideration.
- 3. A student must complete the requisite ELICOS requirements, at an authorised ELICOS Provider, as indicated as necessary by the AEAS Test, before schooling can commence at St Catherine's School.
- 4. A student must provide a copy of their School Reports from the previous year and must have completed the previous year level in their own country before they can begin the next year level at St Catherine's School i.e. students applying for Year 10 must have completed Year 9 or its equivalent in their country of residence
- 5. Students who are unable to access AEAS Testing Centers will be expected to complete a Written Test initiated by the school with an authorized agent.
